SKK STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. GOD

We believe that there is only one true God, eternally existing in three persons—The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. All the three possess equal attributes of Deity and personality.

2. JESUS CHRIST

We believe that Jesus Christ is the second in the Godhead. He is one hundred percent God and one hundred percent man. Jesus was born of the virgin Mary, died on a cross, rose from the dead the third day, and ascended into heaven and seated in the right hand of God and that he is coming again to take the believers to heaven and judge the unrighteous in the lake of fire. SAUTI YA KANISA KENYA (SKK) RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA:

All members must meet specific criteria for admission.
Ensure alignment with the organization's values and objectives.

2. RE-ADMISSION PROCESS:

Follow a structured process for any member seeking re-admission, including an evaluation of commitment and adherence to group rules.

3. COMMUNICATION CHANNELS:

Direct official concerns or inquiries to the office of the Director of Administration and Communications using designated titles.

4. LANGUAGE USAGE:

Maintain a high standard of communication; refrain from using offensive or disrespectful words at all times.

5. COMPARISON AVOIDANCE:

Avoid comparing the organization with others; focus on the uniqueness and strengths of SKK.

6. LEADERSHIP RESPECT:

Show respect to the leadership at all times; encourage constructive criticism expressed respectfully and privately.

7. TEAM WORK EMPHASIS:

Foster teamwork and collaboration among members; encourage working together towards common goals.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY:

Members should be cautious about private conversations, refraining from gossiping or spreading rumors. Uphold a culture of trust and confidentiality.

9. CONTRIBUTION AND PARTICIPATION:

Encourage active participation and contributions. Non-participation in two contributions may be deemed uncooperative.

10. DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS:

Outlined consequences for rule violations include warnings, temporary suspension, or permanent expulsion based on severity.

11. **MANDATE OF DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS:**

Only the Director of Operations is authorized to add and readmit members on the members' wall. Adhere strictly to this protocol.

12. **OFFICIAL TITLES:**

Utilize the official titles provided by leadership when referring to positions, maintaining uniqueness and professionalism.

13. **UNIQUE IDENTITY:**

Emphasize the distinctive nature of SKK; avoid replicating rules or procedures from other groups. Celebrate and showcase uniqueness.

14. **CONFIDENTIALITY REMINDER:**

Reinforce the importance of confidentiality within the group; members must uphold the privacy of discussions and interactions.

15. **CUSTOMIZED COMMUNICATION:**

Craft communications reflecting SKK's unique identity. Avoid generic language; tailor messages to resonate with values and culture.

16. **DISTINCTIVE LEADERSHIP TITLES:**

Use the official titles provided by the organization's leadership when addressing or referring to them, contributing to a clear and organized communication structure.

Encourage members to take pride in being part of SKK, showcasing the organization's distinctiveness, and promoting values and mission.

18. **REGULAR TRAINING:**

We shall conduct periodic training sessions through the Department of Education to ensure all members are well-informed about SKK's unique features and protocols.


19. **INTERNAL COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL:**
